With his expertise in advanced orthopedics, Dr. Bulovas has been able to help many animals. Recently, an older Labrador Retriever, named Hoku Lani, came into his hospital. One of her knee ligaments was completely torn and her family was very concerned that she would not do well with an orthopedic surgery. Dr. Bulovas and his team rebuilt the joint during a three hour TPLO bone plating procedure. "Hoku Lani is a great success story," he said. "Last week we did the surgery and she is already walking around. It is so rewarding to watch a patient begin to play and become her old self because of a procedure performed just down the road from her house. If she has any problems in the future then we are right here."

The Animal Hospital of The Woodlands all-inclusive design allows for all types of animal and pet care. There is a dental ward where animals can go for everything from general cleaning to tooth extraction. The surgery ward is advanced, allowing for all exploratory and endoscopic, non-invasive surgery and it even has a window view. There is also a digital radiology complex, cardiac ultrasound room and emergency/critical care ward. The hospital also offers a fully-stocked, in-house pharmacy and a laboratory that can do almost any test in 30 minutes, which allows for a quick diagnosis and treatment of most diseases.

One of the most advanced features of the hospital is the seamless, paperless system, which allows for quick, efficient and detailed patient care. This translates to quick communication to all areas of the hospital and better care for the patient and their owners.

The Animal Hospital of The Woodlands also has a bathing/grooming ward with a full-time, professional groomer on staff. “When pets get dropped off for boarding, the owners pick them up fully cleaned and groomed with all their medical conditions checked and treated,” Dr. Bulovas explained. The boarding experience truly is like a vacation for pets. The hospital has 32 climate-controlled dog runs, seven play/social areas and 20 individual boarding cages. There are even 12 cat condos with window views.

The main lobby is designed to feel like a spa, as it has a Tuscan-style design. “It is like nothing you have ever seen before in The Woodlands,” Dr. Bulovas excitedly said. “It doesn’t even seem like a hospital or vet clinic.” For the adults, they have a fireplace and coffee bar. Looking in the other direction, there is a waiting area for the children with continual cartoons playing on a television. They have truly thought of everything to make the experience as pleasant as possible.

Dr. Bulovas even designed a special consultation/grievance room for the rough times when an animal needs to be put to sleep. Instead of saying goodbye to a beloved family pet in a sterile, hospital-like environment, Dr. Bulovas offers this peaceful room with a little sofa. “This is where I can comfortably address the tough issues with the family, because it feels a little more like home,” Dr. Bulovas said. Other consultative services include orthopedic, geriatric, weight management and life-style coaching.
